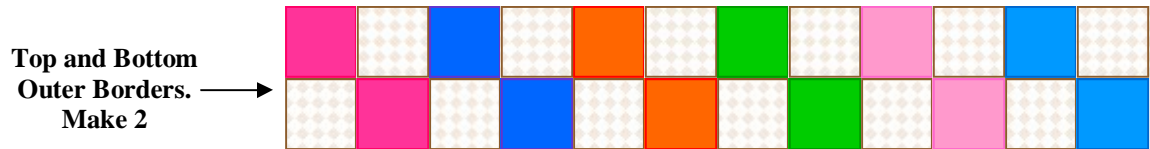
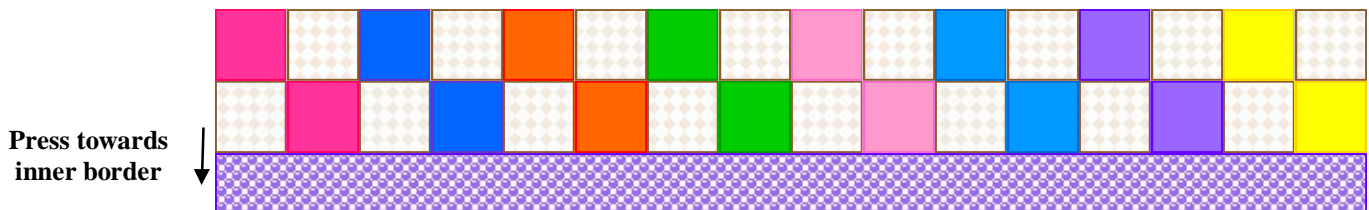
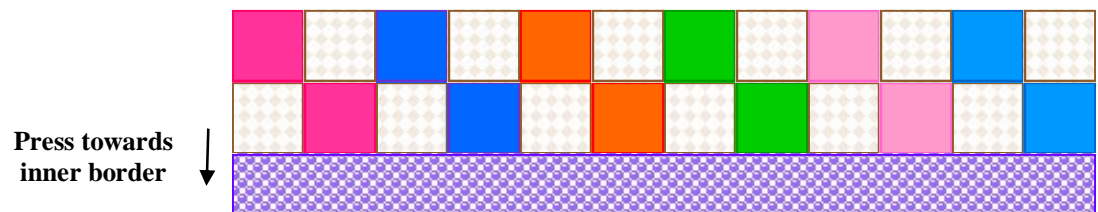


Step 2—Layout

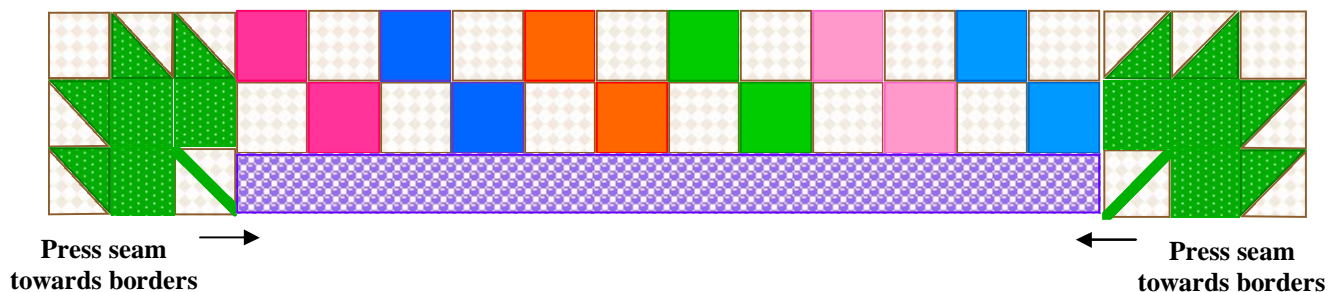
- Lay your 4 patch blocks out in a pleasing pattern, maintaining a checkerboard pattern. You will need 6 blocks for each of the top and bottom borders and 8 blocks for each of the side blocks.
- Sew the 4 patch blocks together. Press. (Your finished 4 patch borders need to be the same length as your inner borders. If they are too long, cut an equal amount off of each end. If they are too short, add another segment to the border.)



- Sew your inner borders to the 4 patch borders. Press the seam toward the inner border.



- Sew a maple leaf block to each end of the top and bottom borders, making sure that the stem of the maple leaf faces inward toward the inner border. Press seam toward borders.



- e) Attach the side borders to the quilt, making sure that the inner border is on the inside. Press seam toward border.
- f) Attach top and bottom borders. Press seam toward borders.
