

Casserole Cover by Carol Baum

Fabric requirements:

- * 1 yard cover fabric
- * 1 yard lining fabric
- * Thread to match
- * 1/4 yd fusible interfacing
- * 1/2 yd Insulbrite or cotton batting

Tools:

- * Rotary Cutter
- * Mat
- * 6"x24" ruler
- * pins
- * Walking Foot

Note: A walking foot is highly recommended.

If you want to cut before you come:

- * 2 - 14" x 40" rectangles of cover fabric
- * 1 - 2" strip by width of fabric; Cross cut into two 18" lengths
- * 2 14" x 40" rectangles of lining fabric
- * 1 2" by width of fabric; Cross cut into two 18" lengths
- * From fusible interfacing cut: 1-1/2" x 17-1/2" rectangles
- * From Insulbrite cut: 14" x 37" rectangle

If anyone saw the quilting motif fabric that my casserole carrier was made from, I have 6 yards of it and will bring it and sell for \$3.50/yd. Bring brown, red, yellow, bright green or muslin for lining fabric.

I also have 7 yards of a different sewing motif fabric. It is country blue with red and white checked fabric patches, scissors, buttons, thread, pin cushions and pins, thimbles which I will also sell for \$3.50/yd.
