“HOUSE BLOCK”
APRIL BLOCK

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Door:	1	2” x 3 1/2” rectangle
House Walls:	3	2” x 5” rectangles
	3	2” x 2” rectangle
Window:	1	2” X 2” square
Roof:	1	8” x 2” rectangle
Chimney:	1	1 1/2” x 1 1/2” square
Background:	2	2” squares
	1	2” x 4 1/2” rectangle
	1	2” x 3” rectangle
	1	1” x 1 1/2” rectangle

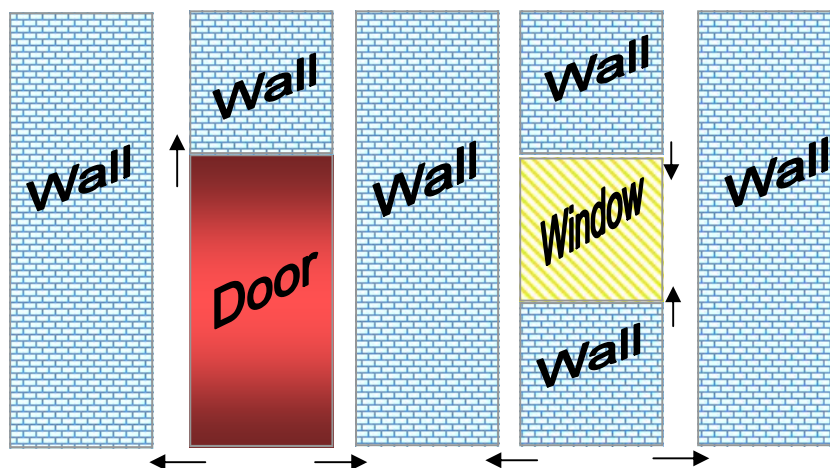
Step 1:

Sew window between 2” x 2” house walls. Press seams toward window.

Sew remaining 2” x 2” house wall to top of door. Press seam toward wall.

Step 2:

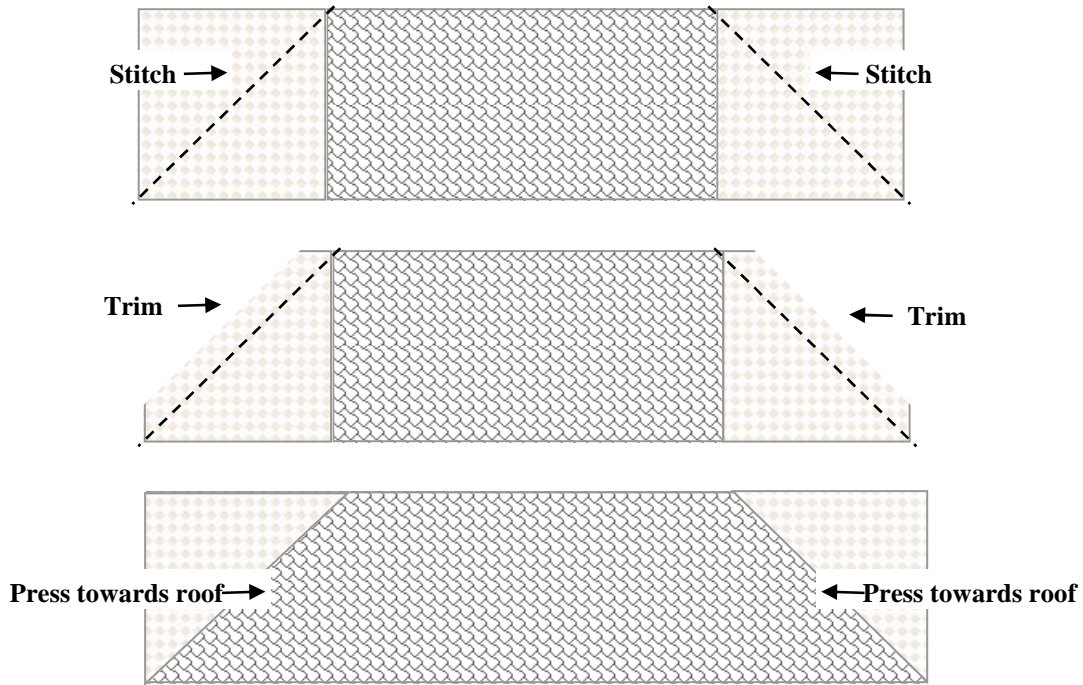
Lay main part of house out as follows:



Sew together with 1/4” seams. Press seams **away from door/wall unit** and **away from window/wall unit**.

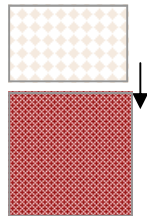
Step 3:

Draw a diagonal line across the back of each of the 2" background squares. Place these squares on roof section, right sides together and sew on drawn line. Trim seams to 1/4". Press toward roof.

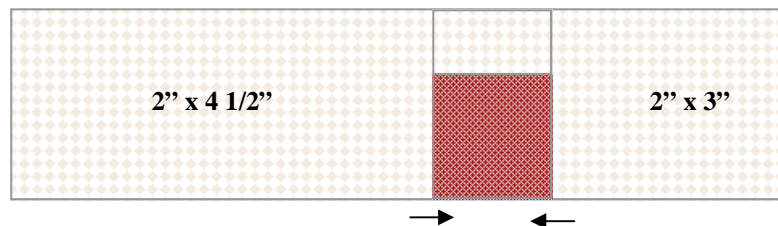


Step 4:

Sew Chimney to 1" x 1 1/2" background rectangle. Press seam toward chimney.



Sew 2" x 4 1/2" background rectangle on the **left side** of the chimney piece and the 2" x 3 1/2" background rectangle on the **right side**. Press seams toward chimney. See drawing below.



Step 5:

Sew chimney section to top of roof section.

Sew roof section to house.

Press seams up.

Block should measure 8" x 8"
