

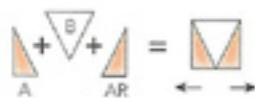
- C 2 1/8" ■ → Cut 4 dark
 D 2 1/2" ▣ → Cut 4 Background 1
 E 4 1/4" ▤ → Cut 2 medium
 F 3 7/8" □ → Cut 1 light



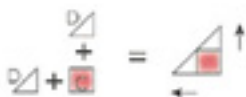
Step 1: Lining up pieces A and B can be a little confusing. With a pencil, draw in the 1/4" seam allowance on all points on A's, AR's, and all B's. This gives you an X to help you accurately match each point.



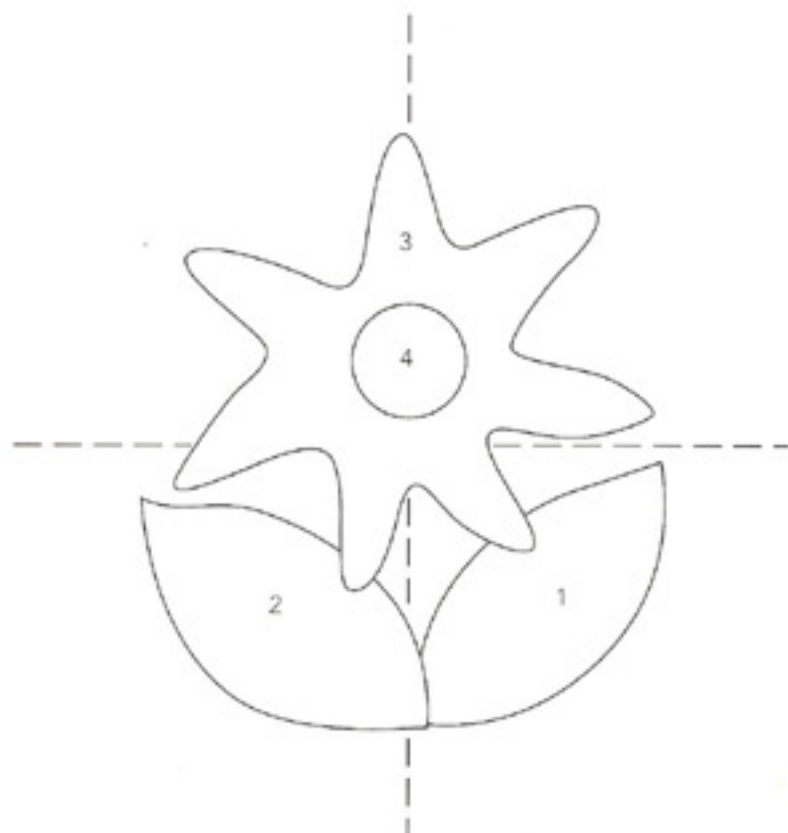
Step 2: Make 4.
